

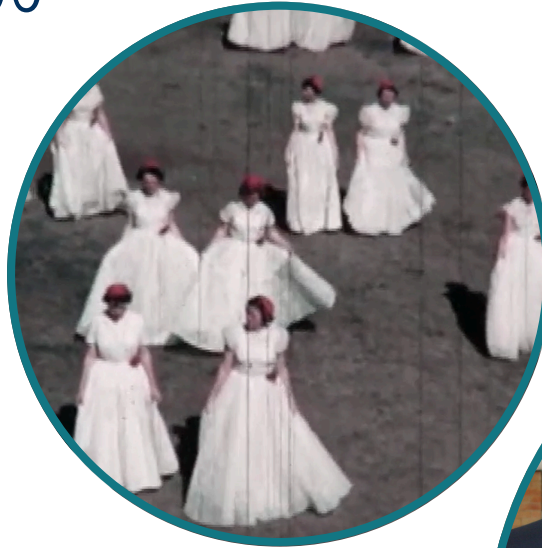

## **Singleton**

Named after Benjamin Singleton, a member of John Howe's 1820 expedition into the area and the person responsible for the establishment of the township.

## **Opened 1875**

**Also opened 1875:** Day and boarding school for girls

**Also Opened 1974:** co-educational high school
